

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY E18/8, STOURPAIN

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. **All foot passengers, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along Public Bridleway E18/8, Stourpaine from grid reference ST 104 852 (point A on the map below) to grid reference ST 858 066 (Point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 1400metres. The reverse route applies.** The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. **It will come into operation on the 17<sup>th</sup> November 2014, for a period of 26 weeks.** But it will remain in force for 6 months and can be, extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

The order is required to allow Investigation and repair works to be carried out on the Bridleway and ensure the safety of the public.

### ALTERNATIVE ROUTE;

From the northern end of the closure [point A] head south east onto Bridleway No.15 over Hod Hill. Continue south east until Manor Road. Continue along Manor Road to the junction of Havelins. Turn right and proceed to point B. (Blue Route) and the southern end of the closure. The reverse route applies.
