

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A350, BLANDFORD ROAD, IWERNE MINSTER

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A350, Blandford Road, Iwerne Minster from the junction with The Paddocks to the junction with Higher Street, a distance of approximately 150 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on [1] 02nd December 2014 at 23:00hrs until 03rd December 2014 at 06:00hrs [2] 03rd December at 23:00hrs until 04th December 2014 at 06:00hrs, a total period of 14 hours. The Notice will be in operation for a period of 5 days.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water to carry out emergency works to repair a mains leak and carry out a permanent reinstatement.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE;

The alternative route, which will be sign posted, is as follows; from the northern end of the closure proceed northward along the A350, to Royal Chase Roundabout. At the roundabout take, the second exit, onto the A30, and to the mini roundabout. Take the second exit, continuing on the A30 to Ivy Cross roundabout. Take the second exit at the roundabout, continuing west on the A30. Continue for approximately 4.3 miles, to East Stour and the junction with the B3092. Turn left onto the B3092, and proceed south for 6.7 miles, into Sturminster Newton, and to the traffic signals at Sturminster Newton Bridge. At the bridge, turn left onto the A357, and proceed easterly along the A357, to Durweston Bridge and the junction with the A350. Turn left onto the A350, and proceed north until Iwerne Minster and the southern end of the closure. The reverse route applies.
