

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH E18/13, STOURPAINE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians, horses and cycles will be prohibited from proceeding along part of Public Footpath E18/13, Stourpaine between Rowlands Road and A350 Shaston Road, an overall distance of approximately 130 metres. The order is needed to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2021 for a period of 26 weeks initially. But can be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

**This closure is required for safety reasons for the general public whilst works to construct dwellings with granted planning permission take place.**
